ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Adopted 9 February 2016

Barley Village Hall will operate their facilities as sensitively and efficiently as possible, taking into account environmental issues, such as effect, impact, scale, legislation and regulations, with a commitment to continual improvement and review.

Specific Policies:

1. Environmental Effect:

Barley Village Hall will review their operations regularly, taking into account use of energy, such as switching off lights not required, controlled heating only to rooms being used and ventilation. Barley Village Hall will conserve resources through efficient use and careful planning.

2. Environmental Impact:

Barley Village Hall will use environmentally safe and sustainable energy sources to meet our needs Barley Village Hall will make an effort to minimise waste and wherever possible recycle materials. All waste will be disposed of through safe and responsible methods, including the operation of a paper-recycling scheme.

3. Environmental Scale:

Barley Village Hall will ensure that efficient use of space is a priority regarding the use of rooms, so that rooms appropriate to the numbers of occupants are arranged, to avoid unnecessary heat/light loss.

4. Legislation and Regulations:

Barley Village Hall will review this Policy annually, taking into account new guidelines and government directives.

5. Users of Barley Village Hall:

In addition to abiding by the policies detailed above, all parties hiring out or otherwise using Barley Village Hall are responsible for the removal and appropriate disposal of any waste generated whilst using the Hall.
